**The matter**

Licence to use radio transmitters, according to the Electronic Communications Act (EkomL)(2003:389).

---

**Determination by the National Post and Telecom Agency**

The National Post and Telecom Agency grants XXX a licence to use a radio transmitter for the provision of public electronic communications services using digital technology.

The licence applies the date of allocation and for 15 years hereafter.

The licence is subject to the following conditions.

**Conditions**

**1 Kind of electronic communications service, technology, frequency space and territorial scope**

- 1.1 The licence covers public mobile electronic communications services using digital technology within the borders of Sweden.
- 1.2 The frequency space comprises 463.0 - 464.8/453.0 - 454.8 MHz, including the guard band against neighbouring licence holders.

**2 Coverage**

- 2.1 Coverage means a signal strength that allows speech, with a handheld terminal, at 1.7 metres above ground level outdoors and with an area probability of 90 per cent.
- 2.2 The licence holder shall, no later than 1 July 2007, cover 80% of the land area in each individual county in Sweden. County means the

counties of Sweden, according to the county boundaries as of 1 January 2004.

- 2.3 Within the coverage area, the licence holder shall ensure that public electronic communications services are provided in the form of a mobile telephony service.

### **3 Technical requirements**

- 3.1 The licence holder shall radio plan the network itself.
- 3.2 Radio planning shall be conducted within the frames for the coordination agreements with other countries.

### **4 Term**

- 4.1 The licence, together with associated conditions, applies, as of today and for 15 years hereafter.

### **Information**

1. Applications seeking a licence to use individual radio transmitters for the radio use should be submitted to PTS.
2. Mobile terminals, which are connected to the licence holder's radio network through subscriptions, shall be exempted from the licence obligation in accordance with Section 5, item 2 of PTS's Regulations on exemptions from the licence obligation for certain radio transmitters (PTS Code of Statutes (PTSFS) 2004:8).
