

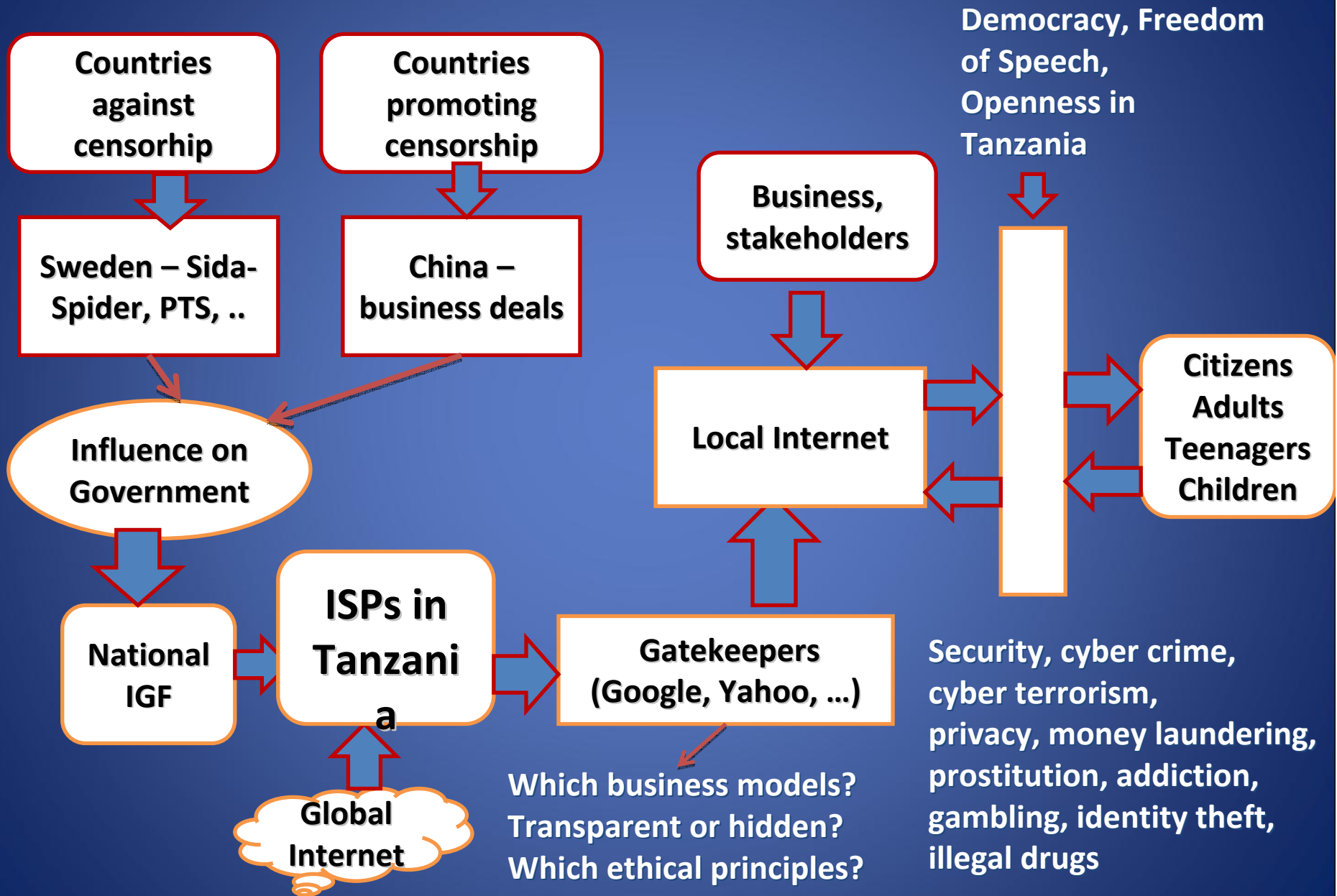

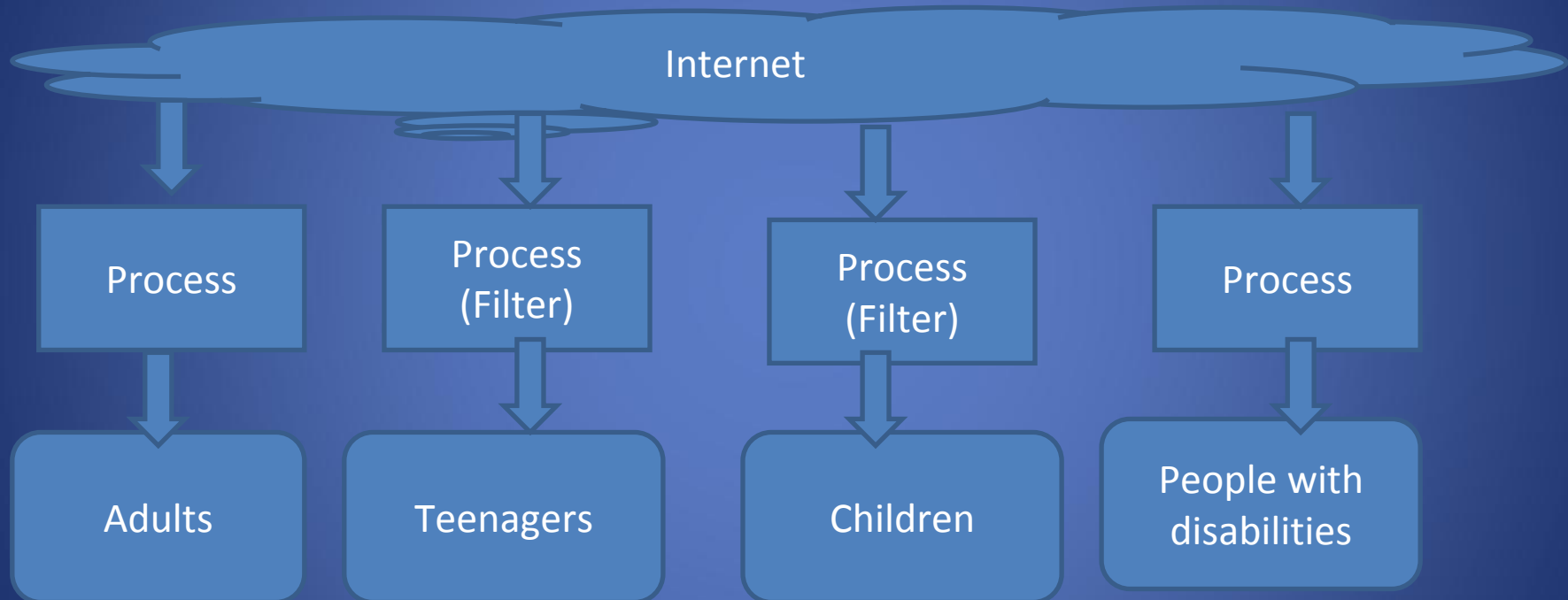

What is a child? What is harmful for children? How could we filter out harmful content?

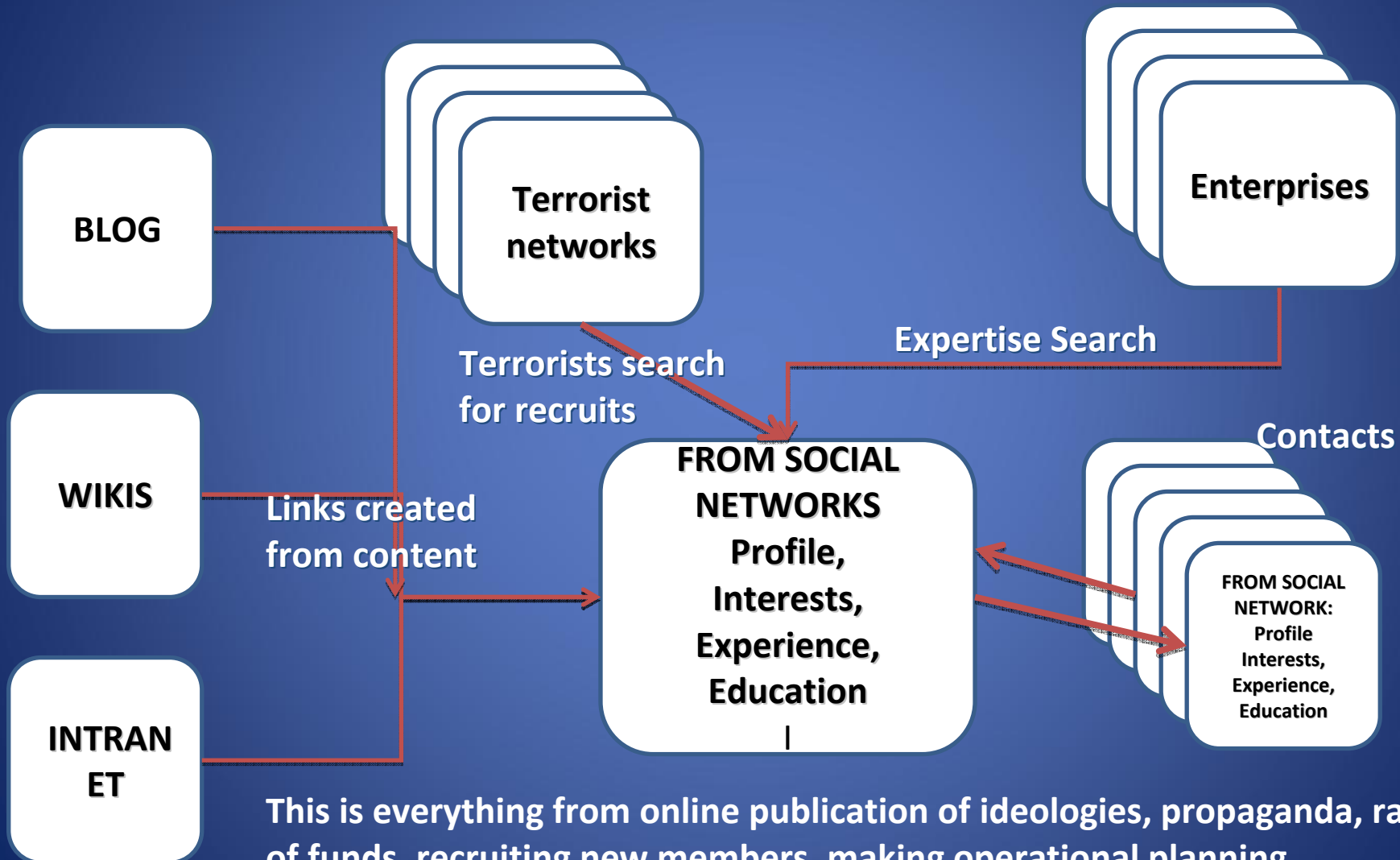
What is teenager? What is harmful for teenagers? How do we prevent addiction so that children and teenagers should not over use ICT technology?
