Information to applicants concerning exemption from license obligation for certain earth station operation in Sweden

The Agency would like to inform that following type of land earth station is, since 2008-10-01 and according to revised Direction on Exemption from License Obligation (PTSFS 2008:4), exempted from individual license requirement in Sweden, and on following conditions:

- *Frequency band: 14.0–14.5 GHz and 29.5–30.0 GHz*
- *The satellite terminal (the land earth station) must be under the control of the associated satellite network.*
- *Near airports the e.i.r.p. values presented in the table below are to be used as maximum allowed e.i.r.p. values:*

<i>< 34</i>	<i>34–50</i>	<i>50–55.3</i>	<i>55.3–57</i>	<i>57–60</i>	<i>>60</i>
<i>Minimum distance to airport boundary (meters)</i>					
<i>0 m</i>	<i>500 m</i>	<i>800 m</i>	<i>2300 m</i>	<i>3500 m</i>	<i>15000m</i>

If the use is exempted, then there is no need to notify the Agency, and no fees to be paid to the Agency.

Please note that if the intended earth station operation does not meet all of the conditions stipulated above, then the earth station operation is not exempted from license requirement. In such a case one is kindly requested to send a license application to the Agency.
