Appendix B1 – Questions for assessing whether radio usage according to the licence application can be assumed to cause harm to the national security of Sweden

This document is a non-binding translation to English of the Swedish appendix published 5 June 2024

- 1. Provide, in general terms, a description of the intended use of the licence.
- 2. Does the applicant assess that the planned business activities (*or* part of the business activities) will have, or could have, an impact on the national security of Sweden?
- 3. Describe which of the applicant's owners that are judged to have a significant influence over the applicant's business activities. If the applicant anticipates changes in ownership, then this must be stated in the description.
- 4. Provide details of which individuals are members of the applicant's board of directors, or equivalent.
- 5. Assuming that the applicant is awarded a licence in the current award process, describe, in general terms:
 - a. Planned system architecture, including core network, radio access network, operation (including supervision) and maintenance systems.
 Also describe whether existing infrastructure is intended to be used in any part of the network.
 - b. The planned locations of operation and maintenance systems.
 - c. The main suppliers and subcontractors the applicant plans to engage in order to provide radio access network and core network (including installation, operation and management).
 - d. Which specific requirements for security and supervision measures that the applicant has identified and how these requirements will be met.
