Agreement between the National Telecom Agency, Denmark and the National Post and Telecom Agency, Sweden concerning the use of the frequency bands 876-880/921-925MHz

### Section 1 - Use of channels from

- 1.1 Denmark may use the UIC channels 1-9 without coordination with Sweden, if the field strength of every single carrier produced by a base station does not exceed 36 dBuV/m at the Swedish coastline.
- 1.2 Sweden may use the UIC channels 11-19 without coordination with Denmark, if the field strength of every single carrier produced by a base station does not exceed 36 dBuV/m at the Danish coastline.
- 1.3 Denmark may use the UIC channels 10-19 without coordination with Sweden, if the field strength of every single carrier produced by a base station does not exceed 19 dBuV/m at the Swedish coastline.
- 1.4 Sweden may use the UIC channels 1-10 without coordination with Denmark, if the field strength of every single carrier produced by a base station does not exceed 19 dBuV/m at the Danish coastline.

### Section 2 - General

- 2.1 A field strength exceeding above mentioned levels shall be coordinated with the other country.
- 2.2 Preliminary coordination may take place between the UIC operators concerned. The results from preliminary coordination between operators must be approved by the administrations.
- 2.3 The above mentioned field strength values are to be calculated at a receiving antenna height of 1.5 m and for 50 % of time and 50 % of locations.
- 2.4. A complaint in case of interference shall be based on the median values of measurements of field strength performed at least on two different occasions over a range of at least 100 m of the tangent of the wave propagation of an interfering base station. Measurements of field strength shall refer to the coastline.
- 2.5 For this agreement only, the coastline of Denmark shall be defined as excluding the islands of Middelgrunden, Flakfortet and Saltholm, and the coastline of Sweden shall be defined as excluding the island of Ven.

### Section 3 - Revision


3.1 This agreement may otherwise be revised or cancelled as desired by one of the administrations with a notice of three months.
