## Appendix B2 – Supervision plan for coverage and deployment conditions in the 2.1 GHz and 2.6 GHz bands

This document is a non-binding translation to English of the Swedish appendix (to the Open Invitation Part 2) published 26 April 2023

The PTS supervision plan includes the following documentation and dates. The supervision plan is attached to Open Invitation Part 2 for information and may be amended as necessary.

Anyone operating under the Electronic Communications Act is obliged to provide PTS, upon request, with the information and documents necessary for verifying compliance with the conditions imposed under the Act.

PTS intends to convene an initial supervision meeting approximately one year after the start of the licensing period for licences with coverage and deployment conditions in the 2.1 GHz and 2.6 GHz bands.

## Documentation to be submitted and overall timetable

No later than 31 December 2028 (the first reporting deadline) and 31 December 2029 (the second reporting deadline) the following material must be submitted to PTS:

- Electronic map material showing the estimated coverage of the designated railway for data services, the geographical location of the sites used to provide this coverage and the technical configuration of the sites in terms of antenna height and directions.
- Presentation of the plan, through 31 December 2030, for new sites to be brought into service as well as the coverage they will generate in order to meet coverage and deployment conditions.
- Resolution and format of map material pursuant to agreement with PTS.
- Description of how the coverage is based on the assumptions and requirements contained in the coverage and deployment conditions.

No later than 31 December 2030 (the final reporting deadline), the following documentation must be submitted to PTS:

 Electronic map material showing the estimated coverage of the designated railway for data services, the geographical location of the sites used to provide this coverage and the technical configuration of the sites in terms of antenna height and directions.
